# Mission for the Blind

The Blind Mission is a Reformed Christian ministry in Hungary dedicated to serving people with visual impairments through spiritual care, community support and accessible Christian resources. The mission has produced more than 3,100 audio materials and sends out nearly 50 Braille Bibles every year to support blind and partially sighted people. The mission is currently connected to around 1,500 visually impaired individuals, with a core community of about 100 regular participants, and the work is supported by approximately 30 volunteers nationwide.
